SOUTHERN ILLINOIS TRACTOR PULLERS

GENERAL RULES: ALL CLASSES

1. Drivers must be 14 years of age or older. Those under 18 must have written parental/guardian permission.
2. Drivers must stay on the seat of the tractor at all times. Hands must be on the steering wheel, hand brakes, hand clutch, or throttle at all times during the pull.
3. Any tractor or puller found to be unsafe or illegal may be disqualified or barred from hooking. No alcoholic beverage will be permitted.
4. Any tractor part falling off while pulling and hooked to the sled will result in DQ.
5. Tractor must stay in bounds at all times.
6. Any tractor can pull in a maximum of two classes. One hook per class. Promoter can add number of pulls per day.
7. Drawbars must not exceed 20 inches in height or be less than 18 inches from center of axle to hooking point. NO part of draw bar may extend rearward beyond rear tires and cannot be more than 11 feet from the center of the rear axle to furthest point forward.
9. No steel wheels. Two-wheel drive only. No duals.
10. Tractors must be naturally aspirated.
11. Gas, Diesel, or LP fuels only. No alcohol or nitrous oxide fuels may be used in tractors. Gas is allowed a maximum of 750 specific gravity. All tractors are subject to random fuel checks. Tractors manufactured to use diesel fuel only cannot be converted to gas or LP.
12. RPM's and MPH will be checked from 1/2 track until the pull is completed. RPM's allowed will be determined by the M&W Chart. Any tractor not listed will use manufacturer's data. 20% margin of error will be permitted for all classes.
13. Tractors must have the stock from, engines, transmissions, rear end and axle housing or manufacturer's replacement.
14. Enhanced electrical systems will be permitted in all classes. No rev limiters allowed.
15. Heads, blocks, (jugs), manifolds must be the same manufacturer as the crankcase and frame. (Replacement manufacturer allowed.)
16. Any agricultural type carburetor allowed. Must be the same number of barrels, throats, and draft direction as originally manufactured.
17. Spacer plates and girdles will have no more than 1 inch above and below the center-line of the crankshaft.
18. Judges or promoters decision is final at all times during the pull.

Farm Stock 3 MPH – 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6500, 7500

Open 6 MPH – 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6500, 7500

ADDITIONAL CLASSES MAY BE ADDED TIME PERMITTING.

SATURDAY AT 3:00 PM

Farm Stock – 3500, 4000, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6500

Open 4 MPH – 3750, 4250, 4750, 5250, 5750, 6250

Open 8 MPH – 3750, 4500, 5000, 5500, 6500, 7500

FARM STOCK: 1. Tire sizes 15.5 X 38 max. or 16.9 X 30 (16" rim max) 3500# - 6500# classes, Tire size 18.4 X 38 (16" rim max) 7500# - 8500#. MAY CUT TOP BAR OF TIRE PER AL MAHNKE. 2. Farm stock will run any gear (3 MPH) . 3. Pressed wheels are allowed. 4. 1958 and older.

OPEN 4 MPH: 1. Will pull any gear (4 MPH). 2. Tire size will be 18.4 X 38. 3. 1958 and older.

OPEN 8 MPH: 1. Will run any gear (8 MPH) 2. Tire size will be 18.4 X 38. 3. 1958 and older. 4. Dead man throttles are recommended! If operating hand clutch tractor, hand must be on the clutch while pulling.
