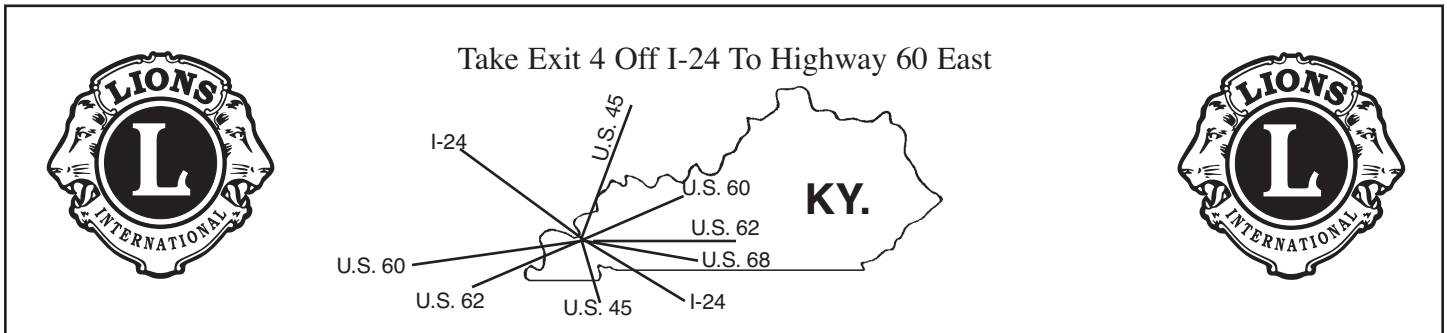


LONE OAK LIONS CLUB 33rd ANNUAL ANTIQUÉ GAS ENGINE & TRACTOR SHOW

TRACTOR PULLS - FRIDAY & SATURDAY NIGHTS

(Thursday PM is set-up day - Friday, Saturday & Sunday are show days.)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ALL EXHIBITORS - Enter and leave Carson Park by the back gate on 30th Street. (Front gate is located on 28th Street)

***GAS, TRACTORS FARM EQUIPMENT** - You will be directed to your show location. After marking off your boundaries, go immediately to "Registration Tent" and register.

GASOLINE - will be issued on two hour basis to running gas engines as you need it. Gasoline issued to tractors used in parade only.

AUTOS AND TRUCKS - not associated with your display must be parked on the race track. Trucks used to haul tractors should be parked against back fence, inside race track, in upper left field.

TRACTORS - when entering and leaving upper field use opening in fence beside "Registration Tent" or on opposite side of track. (This is to help cut down on so much dust at center entrance).

FLEA MARKET - you will be directed to your location. After you set up a Lone Oak Lion member will take your space rent for Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Thursday thru Sunday electricity will be \$2.00 per day in addition to the \$25.00 booth space 18'x20'. After being assigned your space be prepared to set your tables in place, or rope off space with name. First come, first served, except for those who reserved the same space last year by paying a deposit. Only two person per booth. Over two person must pay a spectators. Kentucky law requires you to collect and pay 6% sales tax on all you sell.

FOOD - To help us increase our profits on the show, please eat with us. All profits go to charity. All workers donate their time. For Breakfast - Bacon, sausage, eggs, gravy and biscuits. For Lunch and Dinner - Barbeque plates, pork, ribs & chicken and sandwiches. Hamburgers, hot dogs, Bratwurst, Coffee and Soft drinks, ice cream & cakes.

3 WHEELERS, MOTORCYCLES, BICYCLES, HORSES, AND WAGONS - MUST NOT BE RIDDEN AMONG EXHIBITORS. Please use outside of race track. (When riding on gravel road, do not stir up dust.) **No operators under age 16.**

PARADE - Register for parade at "Judges Stand" - animals, autos, tractors, on foot, trucks, anything that can be put in parade, including antique gas engines on trailers - anything that can move or be dragged. Be ready to move out Saturday at 10:30 A.M. Line up will start at 10:00 A.M. Sunday line up at 12:30 P.M. Parade at 1:00 P.M.

*•SPECIAL NOTICE - Carson Park is a training track for harness race horses. On the week of the show horses will have the use of the track until noon on Thursday. When crossing the track, stop and look both ways for the horses. Give them plenty of room for they spook easily. We don't want to hurt anyone or a horse. **NO ONE ALLOWED ON INFIELD BEFORE 1:00 PM ON THURSDAY.***
